

# This half term Year 1/2 are learning about:



## English

Year 1

In English we are looking at the story The Little Red Hen where we will be looking at and using question marks and exclamation marks. Following this we will be looking at instructions for how to plant a seed using time adverbials.

Year 2

In English this term, we will be looking at instructional writing and focusing upon the use of present tense, adverbs, commas and commands. Following on from this, we will be learning about 'Rags to Riches' story types with an adaptation of Jack and the Beanstalk – our story is all about yummy jellybeans! We will focus upon contractions and suffixes.

## Maths



Year 1

We are learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will be looking at multiplication as 'groups of' and equal parts. Learning to read and draw arrays for different multiplication problems. After this, we will be learning about division through sharing equal groups.

Year 2

We are learning to tell the time this term. We will be revising o'clock and half past before moving on to quarter past and to. After this, we will be measuring in centimetres and metres and looking at how heavy objects are. We will continue to revise our four operations during morning work.

## Science – Plants

Year 1 will be learning to name different wild and garden plants and trees and gather data on which plants we find. We will learn about deciduous and evergreen trees, labelling and locating the different parts of a flowers and trees.

Year 2

This unit we will be observing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and we will be finding out what plants need to grow and stay healthy. We will be introducing the concept of fair testing throughout our scientific investigations.

## Topic – Food Glorious Food

We will be looking at the history of Elizabeth I and her contributions to the nation, focusing in particular on the new and different types of food brought in to England during her reign. We will be comparing the food of rich and poor people during those times and exploring if these were healthy diets. We will be learning about the countries and capital cities that make up the United Kingdom. Identifying where they are in the UK and world and their characteristics and weather patterns. We will be learning about if a country is hot or cold in relation to the equator and North and South poles.

## DT

We will be discovering where food comes from and designing and preparing a healthy meal.

## PE

Year 1

In PE we will be improving their dance skills using Val Sabin's 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

Year 2

In PE, we will be focussing upon our throwing and aiming skills so that we can then apply these to games of dodgeball. In gymnastics, we will continue to develop our rolls, jumps, balances and ways of travelling styles.
