Mathematics



This term, we are developing our understanding of numbers by comparing amounts and exploring the composition of numbers up to IO. We will be practising counting beyond 20 and learning important number facts like doubles. We will also be learning the days of the week and working towards being able to recite them in order.

RE

We will be exploring our new topic, 'Creation and Covenant', where we will learn that God made us, our families, and the world because He loves us. We'll also explore how to care for His creation through activities like litter picking, recycling, and saving energy by turning off lights.

PSHE
