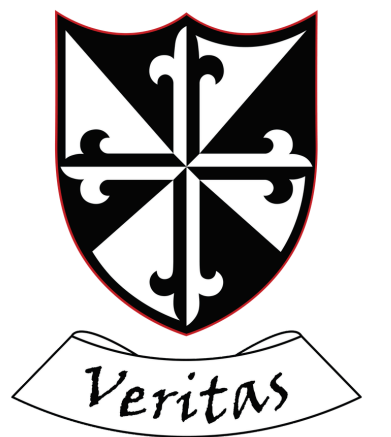


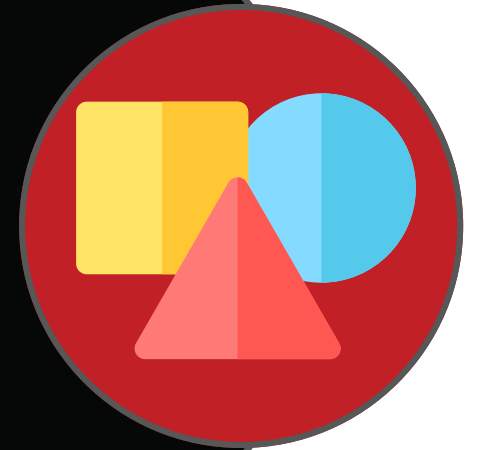
EYFS Newsletter

PENTECOST 1



Mathematics

This half term we will be continuing our subitising skills through complex arrangements within 6 and with using our rekenreks. We will begin to look at the composition of numbers within 5 when a part is hiding before moving on to looking at compositions of number to 10. We will also be continuing our learning of 2D and 3D shapes, weight and height.



English

In English this term, we will be looking at the book 'The Extraordinary Gardiner'. In this story we will learn about different plants and have a go at creating and naming our own before writing simple instructions on 'How to Plant a Seed'. We will then look at the story 'My Shadow is Pink' and create our own shadow puppet describing what it can do

Religious Education

Our RE topic this term is 'Ends of the Earth'. In this topic we will learn about Jesus' ascension to be with his father and His special friend he sent down; The Holy Spirit on Pentecost day. We will learn that Pentecost is the churches birthday and the start of a modern day church. We will learn that Jesus gave us a special job to do, which is the spread the Good News to others.



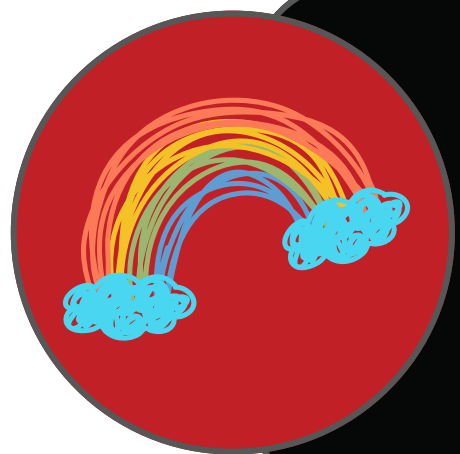
Understanding the World

This half term we will be learning about St George's Day and why we celebrate this day. We will look at different castles and knights and create our own shields. We will look at space and the plants to celebrate World Space Day before finally learning about our teeth and how to keep them healthy.

Physical Development

In PE this half term, we will be learning the different skills and techniques used when taking part in sports day. We will learn how to run a relay race, take part in the egg and spoon and sack race as well as a water relay race. We will continue to develop our kicking, throwing and catching skills in outdoor provision.





Expressive Arts & Design

This half term, we will be looking at creating puppets and props using a range of materials. We will practice looking at different textures to create clothing and backgrounds for our puppets, alongside putting on puppet shows using our props and puppets and musical instruments. Alongside this we will continue developing our cutting and control skills.

We will discuss how to keep ourselves safe in different ways when outside, inside and online alongside exploring money.
