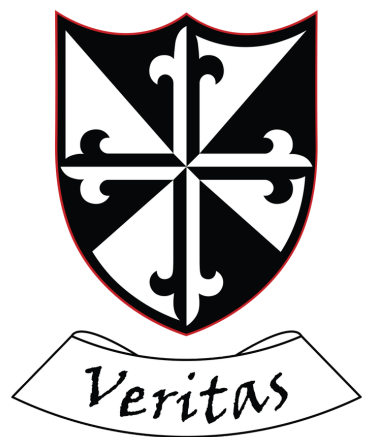


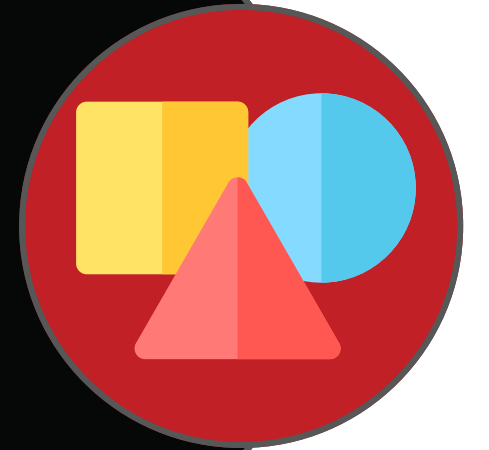

ADVENT 1



Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will be discovering numbers up to 5! We will learn how to count objects carefully, following our careful counting rules. These rules are to touch each one once, one number for each object and the last number we say tells us how many there are in total. We will practice writing numbers to 5 and using our fast eyes to see how many in different representations. Finally, we will look at how to sort objects, simple patterns and length.



English

This half term we will start with learning our phase 2 phonics sounds. We will learn how to accurately say the sounds, write the sounds, hear the sounds in a spoken word and have a go at blending the sounds together to make a word. Our focus book is Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We will taste some porridge and then orally construct sentences to describe it.



Religious Education

Our first branch 'Creation and Covenant' will be looking at our families and how they're similar and different to each others. We will learn about the Church's family and the Sacrament of Baptism and how this makes us a part of the Church's family. Finally, we will look at how the world was created in the Creation Story and discuss how we can look after our world.



Understanding the World

This half term, we will be talking about ourselves and our families. We will explore how our families may be similar or different to others. We will explore the season of Autumn, recognising all the signs we see that Autumn has begun. Finally, we will celebrate with the Harvest and look at what happens during Harvest time and where food comes from.



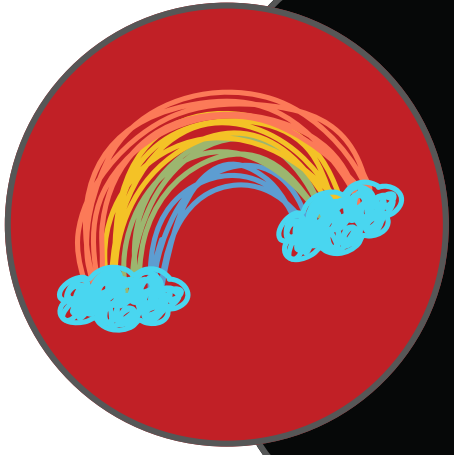
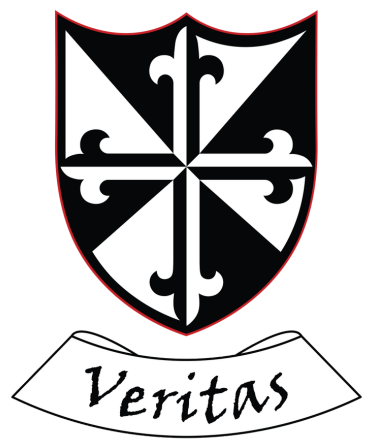
Physical Development

Our first topic will be learning how our bodies can travel and move in different ways and exploring how to move our bodies safely within a space when travelling at different speeds. We will learn and play some simple games and team games to support us with using the space safely.

Expressive Arts & Design

This half term, we will have a focus on using different types of resources such as crayons, felt tip pens and paint. We will learn where we can find these resources and how to use them. We will use junk modelling to create our own designs and creations using glue, scissors and celotape and explore simple crafts using simple instructions.

Personal Development

In our Personal Development sessions, we will be learning that we are all created by God in his image which makes our bodies special. Therefore, we need to look after ourselves and keep ourselves safe. We will also learn that we all have unique and individual gifts which we need to share with others. Finally, that we each have our own likes and dislikes that need to be respected.

- Discuss with an adult our Phonics home learning worksheet which looks at the phonics sounds learnt each week.
- Count beyond 5 and have a go at showing our careful counting skills.
